Eligibility Criteria of the CRC Athlete Position

To be eligible to apply, candidates must have been an International-Level Athlete as defined by the World Anti-Doping Code within the last nine years before taking office (i.e., before 1 January 2024) but shall be retired from competition to ensure sufficient availability to serve on the CRC.

A candidate who was previously sitting on, but is not currently sitting on, another WADA body is eligible to apply. A candidate who stood on the ballot for election to Group 2 or who applied for appointment to Group 3 of the WADA Athlete Council, but who was not elected or appointed, is eligible to apply.
