

## Consequences of non-compliance and reinstatement conditions – Russian Anti-Doping Agency (RUSADA)

 i. Consequences of non-compliance to be applied to the present case in accordance with Article 24.1.12 of the World Anti-Doping Code, as well as Article 11 and Annex B.3.1 of the <u>International Standard for Code Compliance by Signatories</u> (ISCCS)

## Consequences

- 1) RUSADA will lose its WADA Privileges, until the reinstatement conditions set out below are met (see ISCCS Article B.3.1 (a)), i.e.:
  - a. In accordance with the relevant provisions of WADA's Statutes, RUSADA's Representatives (as defined in the Code) will be ineligible to hold any WADA office or any position as a member of any WADA board or committee or other body (including but not limited to membership on WADA's Foundation Board, the Executive Committee, any Standing Committee, and any other committee).
  - b. RUSADA will be ineligible to host any event hosted or organized or co-hosted or coorganized by WADA.
  - c. RUSADA's Representatives will be ineligible to participate in any WADA Independent Observer Program or WADA Outreach Program or other WADA activities.
  - d. RUSADA will not receive any WADA funding (either directly or indirectly) relating to the development of specific activities or participation in specific programs.
- RUSADA's Representatives will be ineligible to sit as members of the boards or committees
  or other bodies of any Signatory (or its members) or association of Signatories, until the
  reinstatement conditions set out below are met (see ISCCS Article B.3.1 (d)).
- 3) The Russian Federation will not be awarded the right to host regional, continental and World Championships, and Events organized by Major Event Organizations, until the reinstatement conditions set out below are met (see ISCCS Article B.3.1 (e.1)).
- 4) The Russian Federation's flag will not be flown at regional, continental and World Championships, and Events, organized by Major Event Organizations (other than the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games), until the reinstatement conditions set out below are met (see ISCCS Article B.3.1 (e.2)).
- 5) The Russian Federation's flag will not be flown at the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games, until the reinstatement conditions set out below are met (see ISCCS Article B.3.1 (e.3)).

## ii. Reinstatement conditions

In accordance with ISCCS Article 11.2.1, RUSADA must satisfy the outstanding critical requirement and comply with all the above-mentioned consequences of non-compliance to be reinstated.
