### 3. Candidate Criteria

- 3.1 To be eligible to apply, a candidate shall meet the eligibility criteria of the Council:
- Be an International-Level Athlete as defined by the World Anti-Doping Code (Code);
  - Be bound by the Code;
  - Must meet the two above criteria within the last nine years before taking office for the first time. The candidate can be re-elected twice for a three-year term but cannot stand on the Council for more than 12 years after his/her (last) fulfillment of the first two criteria.
- 3.2 A candidate who has stood on the ballot for the elections of the Council group 2 and who was not elected is eligible to apply. Members of the IOC AC and IPC AC are not eligible to apply.<sup>1</sup>
- 3.3 A candidate who has been a past member of the WADA Athlete Committee or WADA Athlete Council, including within groups 1 and 2, is eligible to apply, as long as the maximum membership of nine years has not been reached.<sup>2</sup>
- 3.4 The candidate must have reached the age of 18 no later than by the date of the deadline that applications must be received by.
- 3.5 The candidate must not be Provisionally Suspended or serving a period of Ineligibility under the Code.
- 3.6 The candidate must be able to communicate effectively in English. The two working languages of WADA are French and English. The primary working language of the Council will be English.
- 3.7 The candidate must be able to fulfill the requirements outlined in the Council Terms of Reference.
